*Shane Locke Hasbrook Fund for Families and Children

The Porcupine Foundation created the Shane Locke Hasbrook Fund for Families and Children as a permanent endowment with Children's Hospital Foundation in 2002. Thanks to an anonymous gift, the \$25,000 endowment immediately grew to **\$37,500**. Investment proceeds will be used to fund programs for Grief Counseling and the Pediatric Intensive Care at Children's Hospital. In 2003, The Porcupine Foundation committed another \$25,000 to the endowment over five years. This amount was also matched by an anonymous donor, so the endowment fund now stands at **\$75,000**.
